

Thank you for taking interest in CHEDU summer camp!

CHEDU is a Christian organisation that runs camps every summer and winter for South Korean children (aged 10-15) to come over to the UK for a few weeks to learn English. We have been running these camps biannually for the past 6 years and have had the pleasure of seeing many students have a wonderful experience here in the UK, and have seen many grow in their faith and relationship with Jesus.

The actual camp itself lasts 26 days (31st July – 25th August) and consists of the following:

Week 1: (Children arrive from South Korea on Sat 31st July)

Themed English lessons

1:1 conversation practice (one child: 1 leader)

Various activities (including: kayaking, wind-surfing, horse-riding, etc.)

Week 2: The children join WEC Christian camps

Week 3: Day trips to various places in London, Oxford, etc.

Week 4: 4-day trip to Europe

We are looking for enthusiastic and hardworking people to teach English as a foreign language to a small group of Korean children aged 10-15 for one week (**31st July – 2nd August**). The job will involve planning and running classes with a set theme and incorporating fun educational activities to create a fun yet stimulating environment.

(Week 1 payment: £400)

We are also looking for responsible leaders to lead small groups of 3-4 children when going on day trips (**16th-20th August**). This will include helping the children to complete activity sheets relevant to the trip and encouraging them to speak and practise the English they have learned.

(Week 3 payment: £250)
